INFORMATION FOR CONTRIBUTORS

The *Journal of Mammalogy* is a research-oriented, peer-reviewed journal dealing with all responsible types of research on biology of mammals. Manuscripts may be submitted in electronic format (preferred) or as hard copies (details below). Beginning in 2004, manuscripts can be submitted online. (See ASM web site for current status: www.mammalogy.org.)

Preparation of Manuscripts

Manuscripts should be in English. Do not use a separate title page. At upper left of 1st page, print name, address, telephone number, fax number, and e-mail address of author to whom correspondence and proofs should be sent. Next, print a suggested running head (≤ 40 characters). Print title, followed by name(s) of author(s) and, below names, address(es). All articles require an abstract ($\leq 5\%$ of length of text) summarizing key findings. A list of ≤ 10 alphabetized key words should follow the abstract. Where appropriate, a summary in another language may be included at end of text (before acknowledgments). In Acknowledgments, include a statement indicating whether

research on live animals was performed in a humane manner and was approved by an institutional animal care and use committee. Text should conclude with Literature Cited and be followed by figure legends, tables, an appendix (if necessary), and figures. In Literature Cited, put authors's names in upper and lower case letters (not all capitals). Number text pages. All parts of the manuscript, including Literature Cited, should follow style and format of papers in volume 81 or later of *Journal of Mammalogy*. Questions of style can be resolved by referring to the CBE style manual (*Scientific Style and Format--The CBE Manual for Authors, Editors, and Publishers. 6th ed.* Council of Biology Editors, Cambridge University Press.)

Format all written and tabular material to print double spaced (3 lines/2.5 cm). Italicize subheadings and scientific names. In general, 2 levels of organization are used: primary headings (centered and in uppercase) and secondary headings (indented at beginning of paragraph, italicized, and followed by period and dash). The scientific name (genus and species) of all organisms other than domesticated animals should be given with the common name at 1st use, in both abstract and body of paper. All DNA sequences should be placed in GenBank and accession numbers included in the manuscript.

Figures must not be larger than 215 by 280 mm. Put name of author(s) and figure number on figure. Figures will be reduced in publication to 1 or 2 columns (about 8 or 16 cm wide), so lettering, and symbols must be large enough to withstand reduction and be clearly visible. Do not present the same data in both graphs and tables. Color figures will cost \$800 each, which must be paid in full before a paper is scheduled for publication. In general, at least 2 pages of text are needed to accommodate each figure or table, and 3 pages or more are better. Authors who have illustrations of mammals that are particularly attractive or interesting may suggest these be used on the cover of the *Journal of Mammalogy* in which the paper will appear.

To submit a manuscript electronically, put all parts of the manuscript (text, figures, tables, etc.) in 1 word processing file. Format the file in PDF or rich text format and send it, as an attachment, to the Journal Editor, Barbara H. Blake (bhblake@uncg.edu). If it is necessary to submit hard copies, send 3 copies of the manuscript and associated material to the Journal Editor, Barbara H. Blake, Department of Biology, University of North Carolina at Greensboro, Greensboro, NC 27402-6170, USA. Authors will be informed when their manuscripts are

received, and they will be contacted thereafter by the Associate Editor assigned to their manuscript.

Reprints and Page Charges

All authors will be billed \$3.75 per revision for changes in proofs. **Proofs should be corrected as soon as received, signed, and returned to the Managing Editor, Emily Kemmeter, Allen Press Inc., 810 East 10th Street, Lawrence, KS 66044, USA (785-843-1234 ext. 129, fax -1244, e-mail ekemmeter@allenpress.com).** Page charges, \$60 per printed page, may be waived in total or in part.
