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A short running title of no more than 40 to 50 characters should be added. Up to 10 key words should follow.

- 7. Every manuscript has to be preceded by the title, and a summary in German or English giving a synopsis with sufficient detailed information concerning the methods used and the results obtained has to be added.
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should be large enough to permit reduction: drawings should be twice the final size. Important points to note: thickness of lines, size of inscriptions, size of symbols, adequate spacing of shaded and dotted areas. Legend for figures (incl. photographs) should be listed consecutively on a separate sheet of paper.

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Plan all figures to suit a column width of 8.3 cm or a page width of 17.1 cm. Figures may be combined to a maximum plate size of 17.1 cm  $\times$  22.5 cm.

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- a. Periodicals: name(s) and initial(s) of author(s); year of publication; title of the publication; title of the periodical; volume number (Arabic numerals); first and last page number. For journals the recognized abbreviations laid down in the "World List of Scientific Periodicals 1900–1960" (London, 1965) or similar international recommendations should be used.
