

Instructions for Authors

Submission of papers. Papers submitted for publication must be in well-written in English and should be sent to “Z. Phys. Chem. Editorial Office, c/o Martin Radke, Zwickauer Str. 37, 28215 Bremen, Germany” (zpc@martin-radke.de).

Each Contribution must have an abstract which is headed by up to five "keywords" which characterize the contents of the paper.

Authors are asked to use the respective (Word, Latex) stylefile provided by the homepage of the Journal (<http://z-phys-chem.de>) to write their manuscript. Please send together with the original file a pdf.file via e-mail or the Authors' Portal to speed up the review process.

Grey-scale figures should be submitted as tiff files with a resolution of 300 dpi or jpeg files with low compression (high quality).

Line drawings should be submitted as vector graphics in eps format. If reduced to a final size of about 10 cm width, capital lettering should not be smaller than 2 mm. The coordinates should be clearly labeled with appropriate units. Figure captions should be listed on separate sheets.

Tables must be accompanied by self-explanatory headings. All numerical data should indicate the pertaining units.

References are to be numbered consecutively. Abbreviations should follow the "World List of Scientific Periodicals". References should be cited as (for example):

C. Czeslik, O. Reis, R. Winter, and G. Rapp, *Chem. Phys. Lip.* **91** (1998) 135.
or P. L. Yeagle, *The Structure of Biological Membranes*. CRC Press, Boca Raton (2005).

It is possible to reproduce colored figures but the author will be charged with the costs of additional color.

Review process. Manuscripts are accepted for review with the understanding that the same work has not been published or submitted for publication elsewhere. The Editors reserve the right to return manuscripts any time without stating the reasons for doing so. The identity of the reviewers will not be disclosed to the authors or to any other part of the review process. The Editorial Board attempts to reach final decisions on papers submitted within three months.

To facilitate a timely review, authors are encouraged to take extreme care in the preparation of the manuscripts that they submit.

Accepted papers. If and when an article is accepted for publication, the author(s) agree(s) to grant Oldenbourg Wissenschaftsverlag an exclusive and unlimited right to reproduce and distribute the article in any form anywhere in the world.

After typesetting the author will get a galley proof (pdf file) and should feed back the corrections to the editorial office within a week. If costs for subsequent alterations surpass 10% of the original costs of composition, they will be charged to the author.

The author will receive 25 offprints free of charge and the pdf file (with a watermark and stamp) for personal use. Files without stamp can be obtained at <http://www.atypon-link.com/>

Authors of book reviews receive an issue of the journal in which their review is published.
