Preparation of your paper

We welcome manuscripts written in **LaTeX**, particularly if the **Springer macropackage SVJour** has been used (further details below). For papers written in TeX or LaTeX without Springer macros, the source files can in many cases be used, but Springer will decide on a case-by-case basis whether it is more economical to work from the author's files or to typeset.

Papers may be written in English, French, or German, preferably in English.

For style matters please consult previous issues of the journal.

The **list of references** at the end of the paper should always be in alphabetical order and include the names and initials of all authors and the year of publication. Titles of journals and book series should be abbreviated in accordance with *Zentralblatt für Mathematik / Compact MATH* (Index volumes).

Please fill out the copyright transfer statement overleaf and enclose it with your manuscript.
