

# Langenbeck's Archives of SURGERY

## Instructions for authors

*Langenbeck's Archives of Surgery* publishes original papers, review articles, short communications, editorials and other special categories of articles relevant to surgery of the digestive tract, endocrine organ topics, the field of traumatology, vascular surgery and thoracic diseases. Manuscripts must be prepared in accordance with the "Uniform Requirement for Manuscripts Submitted to Biomedical Journals" developed by the International Committee of Medical Journal Editors (N Engl J Med 1991; 3224:424–428). Manuscripts submitted must not be under consideration for publication elsewhere.

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### 1. General

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Data which is of primary interest only to those readers who want more complete data for comparison purposes, will not be printed in the journal. If submitted in electronic form, this material will be put on Springer-Verlag's server and will be accessible free of charge through the World Wide Web at <http://link.springer.de/ol/total/e-supp.htm>.

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Submit four complete copies of the manuscript. Type the manuscript double spaced on one side of the paper only and leave wide margins. Attach full-page photocopies of all figures to the back of each manuscript. Write the last name of the first author and the manuscript number in pencil at the top of each figure. Cite the references, tables and illustrations consecutively as they appear in the text.

### 4. Manuscript

Papers submitted should **not exceed 15 manuscript pages** including references, tables, and figure legends.

Arrange the manuscript as follows: (1) title page, (2) abstract and keywords (3) body of paper, (4) acknowledgements, (5) references, (6) tables, (7) figure legends, (8) figures, (9) permissions.

**Title page:** Provide a complete title (limit: 120 characters). List complete names of all authors and names and full location of department and institution where work was performed. List grant support and other assistance. (Acknowledgements are listed at the end of the text.) If the paper was presented at a scientific meeting, provide a footnote giving the name of meeting, date, and location. Provide the name, complete mailing address, telephone number, fax number and e-mail address of the corresponding author.

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**Acknowledgements:** Limit this paragraph to those persons who have contributed to the scientific study.

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Cite references in the order of appearance in the text using numbers in square brackets. Double
