Acceptable Electronic *Graphics* Files

PostScript (PS) and Encapsulated PostScript (EPS) Tagged Image File Format (TIFF). As part of the production process PS and EPS files are converted to TIFF format. Graphics sent in other formats may be rejected and will need to be scanned.

Things Not to do

1. Please do not send PostScript or Acrobat PDF files of the text. Files must be in a word processing format or ASCII in order to be published.
2. If there are graphics in your word processor file, you must also include the graphics according to the Guidelines for Electronic Graphics Files.
3. Files submitted in a page layout software (such as FrameMaker) will have the math rekeyed.

Simple Guidelines for Final Submission for Publication:

1. Make sure all text elements of your paper are in one file, i.e., title page, bylines/affiliations, abstract, keywords, body of text, acknowledgments, appendices, references and author biographies.
2. Send all figures in separate files in .tif or .eps format (according to the Guidelines for Electronic Graphics Files) and sized to a one or two column width. Type size should be approx 8 pt. and images should be at the appropriate dpi resolution.
3. Tables should be sent as .tif or .eps files along with a clear hardcopy.
4. Required resolution: line art at 600 dpi. Grayscale and author photos at 220 dpi. Color at 300 dpi, indexed color mode.
5. Please include all necessary contact information, including e-mail address, phone number, fax number, and mailing address where proofs may be sent.
