### 4 Manuscript preparation

Authors must indicate whether or not they have a financial relationship with the organization that sponsored the research. They should also state that they have had full control of all primary data and that they agree to allow the EJNM to review their data if requested.

The manuscript should be divided clearly into an Introduction, Materials and methods, Results, Discussion and References. The text should be concise and consistent as to spelling, abbreviations, etc. British English is preferred.

All manuscripts are subject to copy editing.

Short communications should contain a maximum of 1500 words and no more than 6 tables and/or figures. References should be confined to 10. Short communications should include the aim of the study, materials and methods, results, a brief discussion and a conclusion. Titles should be concise and to the point.

- The title page should contain
  - A concise and informative title
  - The name(s) of the author(s)
  - The affiliation(s) and address(es) of the author(s)
  - The e-mail address, telephone and fax numbers of the communicating author

■ **Abstract.** Each paper must be preceded by an abstract presenting the most important results. It must be divided into the following sections:

Purpose  
Methods  
Results  
Conclusions

■ Five **key words** taken from Index Medicus (Medical Subject Headings) should be supplied after the Abstract for indexing purposes.

■ Essential **footnotes** to the text should be numbered consecutively and placed at the bottom of the page to which they refer.

■ **Acknowledgements.** These should be as brief as possible. Any grant that requires acknowledgement should be mentioned. The names of funding organizations should be written in full.

■ The accuracy of **References** is the responsibility of the authors.

The list of **References** should only include works that are cited in the text and that have been published or accepted for publication.

Reference should be *numbered* in the order in which they appear in the text and listed in *numerical order*. Citations in the text should be by arabic numerals in square brackets, e.g. [2, 5, 12]. Journal titles should be abbreviated according to *Index Medicus*. References should be styled as follows:

N.B. Where there are six or fewer authors, all authors should be listed. Where there are seven or more authors, only the first six should be listed, followed by “et al.”.

References such as “personal communications” or “unpublished data” should not be included in the reference list, but should be mentioned the text within in parentheses. A date should be given for both “personal communications” and “unpublished data.”

A paper published online but not (yet) in print can be cited using the **Digital Object Identifier (DOI)**. The DOI should be added at the end of the reference in question.

■ **Illustrations and Tables.** All figures (photographs, graphs or diagrams) and tables should be cited in the text, and each numbered consecutively throughout. Lowercase letters (a, b etc.) should be used to identify figure parts. If illustrations are supplied with uppercase labeling, lowercase letters will still be used in the figure legends and citations.

**Figure legends** must be brief, self-sufficient explanations of the illustrations. The legends should be placed at the end of the text.

**Tables** should have a title and a legend explaining any abbreviation used in that table. Footnotes to tables should be indicated by superscript lowercase letters (or asterisks for significance values and other statistical data).

For **colour illustrations** the authors will be expected to make a contribution (€ 180 plus 16% VAT) towards the extra costs, irrespective of the number of colour figures.

#### 6 Proofreading

Authors should make their proof corrections on a printout of the pdf file supplied, checking that the text is complete and that all figures and tables are included. After online publication, further changes can only be made in the form of an Erratum, which will be hyperlinked to the article. The author is entitled to formal corrections only. Substantial changes in content, e.g. new results, corrected values, title and authorship are not allowed without the approval of the responsible editor. In such a case please contact the Editor in Chief before returning the proofs to the publisher.
