

Overview

Steel Research International is a peer-reviewed journal focusing on – but not limited to – the reporting of advances in steel, steel-related materials and engineering. Categories of contributions include **Research Articles**, **Technical Notes** and **Reviews**. Manuscripts are accepted for publication on the basis of both technical accuracy and importance to a broad readership of metallurgists, engineers and materials scientists. All published manuscripts have been peer reviewed.

Manuscript Preparation

Only manuscripts written in English will be considered.

All submissions require a **title** and 3 – 6 **keywords**.

The academic titles, first names, other initials, and surnames of **all authors** should be given, along with full postal addresses and the e-mail address of the **corresponding author**, who should be designated by a star.

For the **table of contents**, include a color figure and 20 – 50 word summary.

Figures should be tiled whenever possible.

References should be numbered sequentially as they appear in the text^[1] as superscripts in square brackets.^[2-5] The format for listing references is [1] A. Author, B. Author, ... *Steel Research Int.* **2012**, *83*, 100

Supported formats for manuscripts are .doc, .docx, .tex and .pdf. For graphics .bmp, .jpg, .tif, .gif are supported. *Please make every effort to limit the size of your manuscript to below 10 Mb and for all other files to below 2 Mb.*

Image Processing: While a certain degree of image processing is acceptable, and sometimes unavoidable, images submitted for publication should be minimally modified, and any modification to original raw data should be clearly and fully disclosed. Images submitted must accurately represent the original data, and authors must provide, if requested by the editors, unprocessed and raw data to aid in the reviewing process. Image-processing details should be disclosed in full, either in the figure legends, the Experimental section, or in the Supporting Information. This should include the software used and the settings and methods applied in manipulations. Processing should be applied equally to the entire image and also to controls. Processing that obscures data or emphasizes certain regions at the expense of others should not be employed. When used, false-color and nonlinear adjustments, such as gamma correction, deconvolution, filtering, thresholding, and projection, should be clearly indicated in the manuscript.

Categories of Contributions

Research Articles report original experimental and/or theoretical results in 3000 – 6000 words and with up to 8 display items. An abstract is required and citations should be included in the abstract's text, e.g. "...following on previous studies [A. Author, B. Author, *Steel Research Int.* **2012**, 83, 100] ...". The text should be divided into Introduction, Results and Discussion (or Results followed by a separate Discussion section), Conclusions and Experimental. Data must be original and not previously published.

Technical Notes are short, self-contained, reports of 1000 – 2000 words with up to 3 figures that do not require in-depth discussion or characterization but are nonetheless important to academia and industry. Data must be original and not previously published.

Review Articles give a general overview of a particular field, providing the reader with an appreciation of the importance of the work, a summary of recent developments, and a guide to the relevant literature. Manuscripts should be at least 19 000 words in length, divided into appropriate sections, and contain 15-20 display items. A passport-type photo and a short summary (75 words maximum) of the career to-date of the correspondence author(s) should be included, as well as a short abstract and five keywords. Citations made in the abstract should be included in the abstract's text, e.g. "...following on previous studies [A. Author, B. Author, *Steel Research Int.* **2012**, 83, 100] ..."

Manuscript Submission

The author must **inform the editor** of manuscripts submitted, soon to be submitted, or in press at other journals that have a bearing on the manuscript being submitted to *Steel Research International*.

The "[The Ethical Guidelines for Publication in Journals and Reviews](#)" issued by the European Association for Chemical and Molecular Sciences are followed and applied by the editors.

Authors should reveal all **sources of funding** for the work presented in the manuscript and should declare any **conflict of interest**.

Include a brief description of your work in the **cover letter** and, if your manuscript is a re-submission, the manuscript number of the original submission and a description of the changes you have made.

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
