

## INSTRUCTIONS TO AUTHORS

### Submission

Typescripts should be submitted in triplicate to the Editor in chief of the geographic area concerned.

### General

Typescripts should be typed in doublespacing on A4 sheets, and should be numbered beginning with the title page. The first page of an article should contain only: the title, family name, first names, company and address of each author, a short abstract of about 100 to 150 words, and 5 to 10 key words. The name of the author in charge of correspondence must also be given together with his/her telephone and fax numbers and e-mail address.

The texts must be provided on CD-Rom only (text processing).

### Text

The text should be divided into sections with titles and subtitles numbered in the decimal form (1, 1.1, 1.2, 1.2.1, 1.2.2, ..., 2, 2.1 etc).

The units used in the text must follow the SI System. Equations should be numbered in Arabic numerals on the right-hand edge of the page: Eq. 1.

### Figures

Figures (which include graphs, diagrams, photographs in black and white only, etc.) must be presented separately from the text. They must be numbered with Arabic numerals and referred to in the text. Figure captions, which should be presented in the form of a list on a separate sheet of paper, must be as concise as possible, but explicit enough so that the reader does not have to refer to the text for understanding.

### Tables

Tables must be numbered in Roman numerals and referred to in the text. Table captions, written above the table, must be as concise as possible.

### References

The references must be quoted in the text, numbered according to order of appearance and presented as shown - for a periodical:

### Proofs

Proofs will be sent to the designated author to check typesetting accuracy. No changes to the original manuscript will be accepted at this stage. Proofs should be returned within five days of receipt.
