ATTENTION ASHA CEU PARTICIPANTS

Beginning in 2005, ASHA requires journal reading activities to be offered for CEUs based upon word count and readability formulas.

Because each issue of the *Journal of Fluency Disorders* (JFD) may have a different word count, issues will no longer be offered for a set value of 1.0 CEU per issue. Rather, some issues will be offered for more than 1.0 CEU and some may be offered for less. The average will be 1.0 CEU per issue, however.

CONTINUING EDUCATION SELF-STUDY PROGRAM

To enroll in the JFD continuing education self-study program, fill out the registration form, and complete the credit card information or enclose a check or money order for \$60.00 for four issues in one volume. This CEU fee is separate from the journal subscription cost. The CEU fee covers all educational administrative costs for one volume. Although all participants pay the entire annual fee, credit(s) will be submitted only for each journal issue successfully completed.
