Submission

Upload your manuscript Online on <http://mc.manuscriptcentral.com/io> and follow the instructions given

Covering Letter

It is a prerequisite for the submission

- that the article is original,
- that it is not under consideration by another journal,
- that the material has not been published previously and
- that all authors agree as to the content

Manuscript Preparation

Prepare your manuscript using MSWord for Windows®. If you use a different word-processor, submit your text-file as -.RTF file (Rich Text File).

- Use a normal, plain font (e.g., Times Roman) for text.
- Use the automatic page numbering function to number the pages.
- Do not use field functions.
- For indents use tab stops or other commands, not the space bar.
- Place any figure legends or tables at the end of the manuscript.
- Submit all figures as separate files and do not integrate them within the text.

Limitations

- the manuscript excluding references should not exceed a total of 2500 words.
- the title should not exceed 100 characters including spaces.

- the abstract should not exceed 200 words.
- the number of tables should not exceed 3
- the number of figures should not exceed 5
- the number of references should not exceed 25

The **First page** should include initials and the last name of each author with indication of institutional affiliations. The full postal address, including **e-mail address and telefax number** of the author responsible for the correspondence is mandatory. Without it your manuscript will not be reviewed.

Tables. Use the table functions of your word processing program, not spreadsheets, to make tables.

Figures. All diagrams, line drawings, and photographs constitute figures. Figures might be submitted for peer-review as low-resolution images (-.jpg, -.gif, -.tif, or -.eps files). For reproduction in the journal, you will be required after acceptance to supply high-resolution -.tif files (800 dpi for line drawings and 300 dpi for colour and half-tone artwork). Colour illustrations are accepted, but the authors will be required to contribute to the cost of the reproduction. Submitted figures will not be returned.

The list of **References** must be numbered in alphabetical order according to the first author's name. Please note that citation in the text should be by numbers in *square brackets* i.e. [2,6,10]. The style and abbreviations of journals should follow the style used in Medline.

In the online version of *International Orthopaedics* there are automatic links from the reference section of each article to cited articles in Medline. This is a useful feature for readers, but is only possible if the references are accurate. It is the responsibility of the author to ensure the accuracy of the references in the submitted article. Downloading references direct from Medline is highly recommended.

Units of measurement. Measurements must be given in the metric system. Abbreviations for scientific units should conform to the International System of Units (SI).

Abbreviations. Use only standard abbreviations. Avoid abbreviations in the title and abstract. The full term for which an abbreviation stands should precede its first use in the text unless it is a standard unit of measurement.

Accepted Manuscripts. Kindly observe that all accepted manuscripts are edited for language, for scientific clarity and for space. Before publication the edited version will be presented for approval on a personal Web-Site (URL) of which the corresponding author will be notified by E-mail.

Letters to the Editor are considered for publication if they are

- submitted electronically
- do not exceed 500 words and
- do not include more than five references.

Letters referring to a recent journal article must be received within 4 months of the journals publication.
