The *Journal of Gerontological Nursing* publishes manuscripts on the practice, research, theory, and/or teaching of gerontological nursing across the continuum of care.

MANUSCRIPT TYPES AND REQUIREMENTS

Original manuscripts should be no more than 16 double-spaced pages in length, **including** references, Figures, and Tables. Research Brief articles should be 8 to 10 pages in length. Manuscripts that do not adhere to these guidelines will be returned prior to review.

All manuscripts must address the clinical nursing implications of the topic and/or research being discussed. These implications should be evident throughout the manuscript. All manuscripts must also include an abstract of approximately 150 words with a focus on findings and conclusions.

In addition to original articles, the Journal publishes the following sections: Assessment, Clinical Outlook, Genetics and Gerontology, Geropharmacology, Geropsychiatry, Healthy Aging, Innovations in Community-Based and Long-Term Care, Interdisciplinary Care, Legal Issues, Multicultural Aging, Public Policy, Research Briefs, and Technology Innovations. Authors who wish to submit manuscripts to a section should indicate which section in their cover letter.
