

**1. Editorial coverage**

The journal covers all aspects of forest economics, and publishes scientific papers in subject areas such as the following: (i) forest management problems: economics of silviculture, forest regulation and operational activities, managerial economics; (ii) forest industry analysis: economics of processing, industrial organization problems, demand and supply analysis, technological change, international trade with forest products; (iii) multiple use of forests: valuation of non-marketed goods and services, cost-benefit analysis of environment and timber production, external effects of forestry and forest industries; (iv) forest policy analysis: market and intervention failures, regulation of forest management, ownership, taxation; (v) forestry and economic development: deforestation and land use problem, national resource accounting, contribution to national and regional income and employment.

**2. Types of contribution**

Papers reporting original research in any of the above areas are the principal contents of the journal. Review papers and short technical notes are also welcome. Manuscripts will be refereed and, if accepted, published in a coming issue.

**3. Refereeing**

All contributions will be submitted to referees. Names of referees will be kept confidential. In cases of disagreement between the referees, the editors will arbitrate.

**4. General layout of manuscript**

There are no specific instructions concerning the layout of the submitted manuscript. However, manuscripts typed in double spacing on one side of the paper are preferred. Three copies are required. The manuscript should include the following items: (a) titlepage including a short title of the manuscript; an abstract of 50-100 words, a keywordlist, the names and affiliations of all the authors, and the name and address of the corresponding author; (b) the main text; (c) acknowledgments; (d) appendices (if any); (e) references. Tables and illustrations (diagrams, drawings etc.) with captions may be included in the main text. If the paper is accepted for publication the author will receive more detailed instructions concerning the layout and form for submission of the final manuscript.

**5. Manuscripts should be in English**

Both American-English or British-English spellings are accepted; however, each manuscript should use one or other of these consistently.

**6. Proofs and offprints**

The principal or corresponding author will be sent proofs for checking and will receive 25 offprints free of charge. Additional offprints may be ordered on a form which accompanies the proofs.

**7. Copyright**

The Contributor hereby confirms that the Contribution has not been published before (except as part of a thesis or lecture note or report, or except in the form of a working paper that is not published electronically, or except in the form of an abstract); that it is not under consideration for publication elsewhere; that its publication has been approved by all Co-Contributors as well as by the authorities at the institute where the work has been carried out; and that written permission of copyright holders is obtained by the authors for material used from other copyrighted sources. The Contributor hereby assigns to the Publisher the copyright to the Contribution named above. This implies that the Contribution or parts thereof will not be published elsewhere in any language without the consent of the copyright holder. Copyrights include, without spatial or timely limitation, the mechanical, electronic and visual reproduction and distribution; electronic storage and retrieval; and all other forms of electronic publication or any other types of publication including all subsidiary rights. The Contributor retains the right to republish the Contribution in any printed collection consisting solely of the Contributor's own work, subject only to notifying the Publisher of the intent to do so and to ensuring that the publication by the Publisher is properly credited and that the relevant copyright notice is repeated verbatim. In the event of receiving any other request to reprint or translate all or part of the Contribution, the Publisher shall obtain the approval of the Contributor prior to giving any such permission.
