

Instructions for Authors

“Revue Roumaine de Chimie” (Romanian Journal of Chemistry), abbreviated as *Rev. Roum. Chim.*, publishes reviews, original papers, short notes and Book reviews in all fields of chemistry in English, French or German. All manuscripts are refereed; those not accepted for publication are not returned to the authors.

The manuscripts should be submitted in duplicate in computer-printed form along with the floppy-disk version. Manuscripts should be written in Word 6.0 (including abstracts, footnotes, tables and legends), fonts *Times New Roman* or *Times Roman R*, font size 11, double spacing, on one side of quatro paper. Manuscripts should be usually no longer than 7-8 pages; reference list, tables and figure caption will be given at the right place. After the title of the paper, the full name and forename of the authors will be indicated, as well as their affiliation, mentioning the full address of the institution. If there are several authors affiliated to different institutions, letters will be used as superscripts to indicate this (for instance: a,b, etc.). If the paper is a part of a series, reference no. 1 should indicate the preceding part of the same series. The content of the paper should be preceded by an abstract (maximum 150 words) in English, or in English and the language in which the paper is published (when this is not English).

It is insistently recommended to structure the paper as follows: Introduction; Results; Discussion; Experimental; References.

At least once in the articles the correct chemical names of newly synthesized compounds should be given according to *Chemical Abstracts* or IUPAC.

References in the text will be denoted by arabic figures, as superscripts.

Periodicals mentioned as references will be abbreviated using international standards (cf. *Chemical Abstracts*) in italics; the year in which that paper was published (in bold-faced letters) will be placed immediately after the journal name; the volume number will be given in italics; the pages on which the paper appeared will follow. For instance: *J. Am. Chem. Soc.*, **1990**, *112*, 4075-4078.

References of books will include: name of author(s) (with their initials), title of the book, (in “ ”, without being underlined), volume no. preceded by the abbreviation “vol.”, the edition number, as well as the city where it was published, the year, and the

publisher, and in the end, the cited page. For edited books, the names of the editors will be also specified.

Patents will be indicated as follows: author(s) or company, country and patent number, and compulsorily, the *Chem. Abstr.* quotation, e.g. M. Jones (Union Carbide), *Brit. Pat.* 601238 Sept.2, 1959; cf. *Chem Abstr.*, **1960**,54, 12808.

In order to gain printing space, a minimal number of figures and diagrams (2-3) will be included. The rest of original data will be presented in Tables or in the text. Figures, schemes, chemical formulae (including their letters) can be also drawn separately on transparent tracing paper in black ink or printed with a laser print. Figures will be numbered with arabic numbers and will have a legend (presented in the caption to figures on a separate sheet). Tables will be also numbered and will have a title. It is not allowed to present the same data in tables and figures.

The authors are asked to clearly indicate the *italics* and **bold type** letters, as well as special characters such as the prefixes *ortho*, *meta*, *para*, *cis*, *trans*, etc., which should never be printed as capitals.

No hand-made correction on the manuscript is accepted; corrections should be typed.

Manuscripts should be signed by the authors.

The running title should be indicated and should not exceed 50 letters.

In order to avoid delays in publication the foreign authors are not sent page-proofs, corrections being operated by the Editors.

Each paper is entitled to 25 free reprints.

The content of the papers is the exclusive responsibility of the respective authors.
