## Instructions to Contributors

1. Manuscripts, in English and in MS Word format, should be submitted to the Managing Editor:

2. Submission is a representation that the manuscript has not been published previously and is not currently under consideration for publication elsewhere. A statement transferring copyright from the author (or their employers, if they hold the copyright) to Springer Academic/Plenum Publishers will be required before the manuscript can be accepted for publication. The Managing Editor will supply the necessary forms for this transfer. Such a written transfer of copyright, which previously was assumed to be implicit in the act of submitting a manuscript, is necessary under the U.S. Copyright Law in order for the publisher to carry through the dissemination of research results and reviews as widely and effectively as possible.
3. Manuscripts are to be submitted as an e-mail attachment: one e-mail containing all of the related files as attachments.
4. A title page is to be provided and should include the title of the article, author's name (no degrees), author's affiliation, and suggested running head. The affiliation should comprise the department, institution (usually university or company), city, and state (or nation) and should be typed as a footnote to the author's name. The suggested running head should be less than 80 characters (including spaces) and should comprise the article title or an abbreviated version thereof. For office purposes, the title page should include the complete mailing address, telephone number and e-mail address of the one author designated to review proofs.
5. An abstract is to be provided, preferably no longer than 250 words.
6. A list of 4—5 key words is to be provided directly below the abstract. Key words should express the precise content of the manuscript, as they are used for indexing purposes.

7. Illustrations, photographs, drawings, and charts are to be submitted in an electronic format. They should be in TIFF or EPS format (1200 dpi for line art and 300 dpi for half-tones and gray-scale art). Color art should be in the CMYK color space. Each piece of artwork should be in a separate file on the same disk as the manuscript. Artwork should be numbered in one consecutive series of Arabic numerals. Captions for the artwork should be included in a separate file. Identify all files with author's name and number of illustration.
8. Tables should be numbered (with Roman numerals) and referred to by number in the text. Center the title above the table, and type explanatory footnotes (indicated by superscript lowercase letters) below the table. All tables should be included in a separate file on the same disk as the manuscript.
9. List references alphabetically at the end of the paper and refer to them in the text by name and year in parentheses. References should include (in this order): last names and initials of *all* authors, year published, title of article, name of publication, volume number, and inclusive pages. The style and punctuation of the references should conform to strict APA style—illustrated by the following examples:

*Journal Article*

*Book*

*Contribution to a Book*

Knight, R. A., & Prentky, R. A. (1990), Classifying sexual offenders: The development and corroboration of taxonomic models. In W. L. Marshall, D. R. Laws, & H. E. Barbaree (Eds.), *Handbook of sexual assault: Issues, theories, and treatment of the offender* (pp. 23-52). New York: Plenum Press.

10. Footnotes should be avoided. When their use is absolutely necessary, footnotes should be numbered consecutively using Arabic numerals and should be typed at the bottom of the page to which they refer. Place a line above the footnote, so that it is set off from the text. Use the appropriate superscript numeral for citation in the text.
11. In general, the journal follows the recommendations of the 2001 *Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association* (Fifth Edition), and it is suggested that contribution refer to this publication.
12. **The journal makes no page charges.** Reprints are available to authors, and order forms with the current price schedule are sent with proofs.
