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PETER SELL joined the Herbarium in the University of Cambridge's Plant Science Department in 1944, holding the post of Assistant Curator from 1972 until his retirement in 1997. His work there on this flora continues unabated, together with almost daily visits to the University's Botanic Garden throughout the flowering and fruiting seasons. He is co-author of *Flora of Cambridgeshire* (1964) and *Flora of the Maltese Islands* (1977), and was involved in the whole of the *Flora Europaea* project, also published in five volumes (1964-1980).

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
