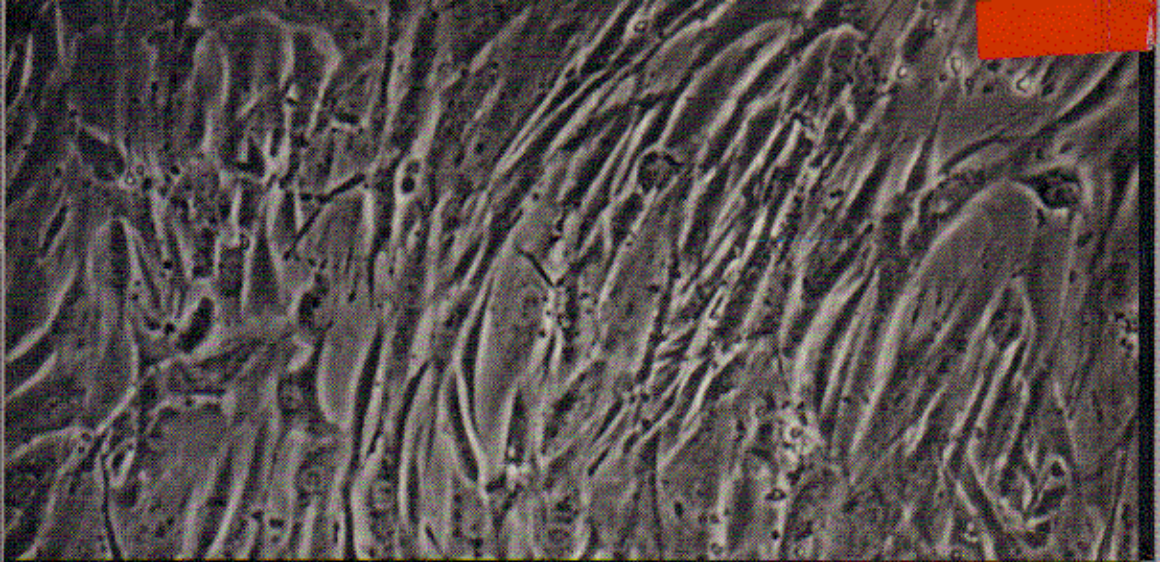




HANDBOOKS IN PRACTICAL ANIMAL CELL BIOLOGY
