



Shortly after its formation in 1972, the Sheffield Bird Study Group undertook a breeding Atlas to map the distribution of breeding species across the Group's recording area, covering 1,200 km² in South Yorkshire and north Derbyshire. Despite being distant from the coast and centred on the country's fifth largest city, the Sheffield area comprises a diverse range of habitats and hosts an excellent array of breeding species. This book analyses the results of a repeat breeding Atlas carried out in 2003-08 and considers the changes that have taken place since the original Atlas to provide a fascinating and up-to-date picture of the region's breeding avifauna.



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
