A school of black jacks (*Caranx lugubris*) photographed at a World War II shipwreck off north-eastern Bali, Indonesia. Black jacks are found in tropical waters across the world, with a particular preference for clear, deep water off coral reefs and seamounts. They feed mostly at night, on other fishes, crustaceans, and molluscs. Black jacks are caught for food by locals in the Caribbean and other island groups along its range.
