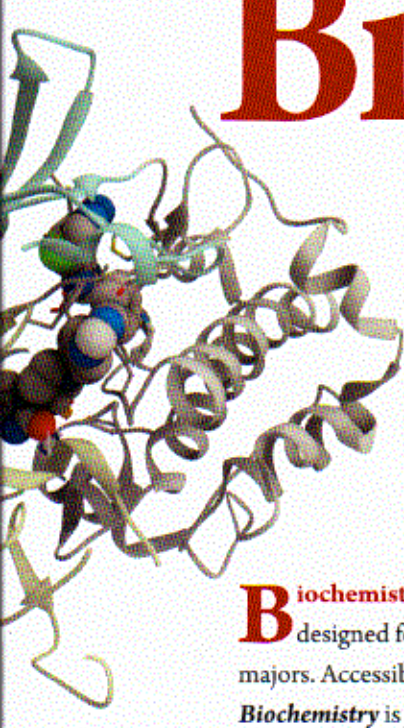


Biochemistry
