

## PREFACE

This study guide provides a brief review of the major ideas in each chapter in outline form as well as a set of test questions with answers.

The purposes of the guide are to help the reader organize the textbook material and to measure for himself his understanding of it.

We suggest that a student read each chapter two or three times first. Then look at the concepts at the end of the chapter and the outline in this manual. If these do not match the ideas the student has derived, he should read the comments on each concept in the manual and then reread the chapter.

When he feels he has mastered the material he should take the multiple-choice self-test. By checking his answer against those given in the manual, he should be able to identify areas of misunderstanding or difficulty.
