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THIS IMPORTANT SYMPOSIUM was the first organized by the Biochemistry Section Committee, a coordinating committee between the International Union of Biological Sciences and the International Union of Biochemistry. In accordance with the committee's purpose of choosing subjects in which both biochemistry and the biological sciences were combined in a rapidly expanding field of knowledge, Biological Structure and Function was chosen as the subject of this first symposium. Seventy-two scientists from eleven countries presented invited papers.
