

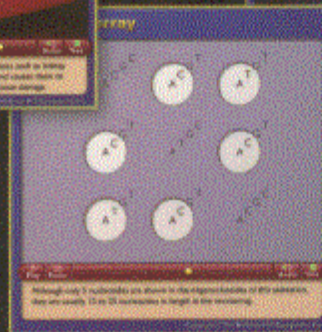
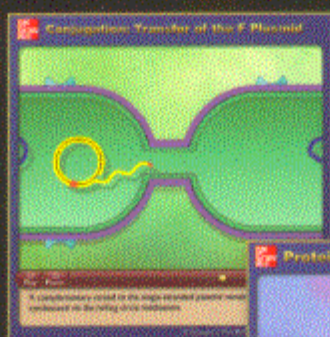
ABOUT THE COVER
