

ABOUT THE BOOK

This volume publishes for the first time specific data for Siberia on taxonomy and distribution of feral members of 31 families. The largest of them are: Umbelliferae, Violaceae, Euphorbiaceae, Geraniaceae, and Onagraceae. Diagnostic features, conditions of habitat, and geographic distribution, with maps of distribution ranges in many cases, have been provided for each species and subspecies.

This information forms an essential scientific base for conservation and utilization of the resources of the plant kingdom.

This book is designed for the use of botanists specializing in various branches including resource specialists, specialists in natural conservation, plant introducers, agronomers, and students.
