

INSTRUCTIONS TO CONTRIBUTORS

ODGOJNE ZNANOSTI (EDUCATION SCIENCES) publishes original research papers, review articles and professional papers which directly or indirectly are concerned with the topic of education in the Republic of Croatia and abroad.

EDUCATION SCIENCES only publishes previously unpublished works. It is issued twice a year (in June and November). The papers should be submitted to the e-mail address: educational-sciences@ufzg.hr as a word document attachment. Please make sure that all the tables and pictures in the paper are black and due to our publishing technique.

Papers, including the summary, bibliography, notes and space for graphic contributions, may not exceed 15 pages, or a total of approximately 30,000 characters.

Graphic images must be printed in black and white on separate sheets not larger than A4 size. The place where the graphic images are to be inserted should be marked in the text.

Where other people's syntagms, ideas, data, terms, etc are quoted, the source is given within the text, and not in footnotes. References are given in brackets and include the author's surname, year of publication, and, in the case of word for word citation, also the page number (for example: Holmberg, 1977, p. 23). The bibliography should provide full information about all the works mentioned in the references. The list should include only works referred to, or mentioned in the text, in alphabetical order according to the authors' surname, and in chronological order for works by the same author, for example:

Holmberg, B. (1977), *Distance Education*. London: Nichols Publishing.

Huppert, N. / Schinzler, E. (1991), *Grundfragen der Pädagogik*. Köln: Stam-Verlag.

Pask, G. (1976), "Styles and strategies of learning", *British Journal of Educational Psychology*, Vol. 46, no. 3, pp 128-148.

Poljak, V. (1980), *Didaktika*. Zagreb: Školska knjiga.

The summary of the paper, up to 150 words, should indicate the purpose of the paper, the most significant outcomes and the conclusion. The summary is submitted on a separate sheet, with the name and surname of the author, the title of the paper, and the heading "Summary".

At the end of the summary, under the heading "Key words", the most significant terms mentioned in the text should be listed in alphabetical order (up to five terms).

An English translation of the summary should also be submitted.
